The Family Center, located at the Kevin O'Grady School in Beverly, provides families with education, resources, and support focused on special needs and at-risk youth. The Family Center is open to the public.

The Family Center offers a welcoming environment with a lending library of books, high quality literature, community resource information and computer access for families. The Family Center provides further support to families through parent support groups, parent trainings and educational workshops.

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

- Library – A comprehensive collection of adult and children's books. Topics include special needs, at-risk youth, psychiatric and medical conditions, behavioral issues, substance abuse and parenting.
- Community Resources – Information on community programs, agencies and recreational activities. Community bulletin board provides up-to-date information on events, support groups and activities offered through community organizations.
- Computer/Internet Access – Links to high quality resources and websites. Bookmarked sites. Staff is available to assist in research.
- Parent Groups – A time for parents who have children with similar special needs to come together in the Family Center to share ideas, resources and friendship.
- Parent Trainings – Small interactive groups of parents who meet to discuss a specific topic. Groups are facilitated by professionals with expertise in the area. Space is limited for Parent Trainings.
- Workshop Series – Morning and evening educational workshops are presented by experts in their field. Topics vary and are determined by requests from parents and school staff. Free and open to the public
