

Student Driven Automobiles

Students should have a valid drivers' license to operate a vehicle. Students who fail to demonstrate safe operating procedures may lose their privilege to drive to school. Additionally, student drivers may not transport any other student to or from school unless there is parental permission at any age. All student vehicles must be parked in designated student parking. All student vehicles are subject to the same search and seizure policy found in the handbook

Dismissal

- NRHS Staff will supervise all students at dismissal to make certain that all students take their previously scheduled form of transportation.
- Students who drive to and from school follow these same dismissal policies. A student who drives to and from school may NOT drive his/her friends from school at dismissal without permission.
- Students, regardless of their age, are not permitted to "Sign Out" of school during the school day without permission. Early dismissals or temporary changes to their previously scheduled form of transportation must be communicated to school personnel in advance, and may be confirmed with a follow up call or other means, by school personnel. Attempts to alter transportation plans near or at dismissal times will not be facilitated.
