Please see below for details on the services and costs of the NEC community based support services:

FY26 Connection Wraparound Plans (Connections Wraparound Program Brochure) are as follows:

- 1. For \$27,500 our clinicians can work with **two to three** high needs students at any time throughout the school year, and be available for additional consultation as needed.
- 2. For \$44,000 our clinicians can work with **four to five** high need students at any time throughout the school year, and be available for additional consultation as needed.
- 3. Fee for Service Contract (yearlong or student specific); an ongoing agreement to work with your district, accepting referrals based on availability at an hourly rate (\$200 member/\$250 non member.
- 4. Package agreements based on hours (yearlong or for a specific student) as follows:
  - 1. 10 hours @ \$1700
  - 2. 20 hours @ \$3400
- 5. Customized plans individually crafted to the needs of your district.

**FY26 Additional Clinical Services (brochure here):** (to be purchased separately based on staff availability, and billed at an hourly rate or package):

- 1. **Home Assessments:** Available to students in district or attending an NEC school, we can provide an in-depth home-assessment. Includes parent and student interviews, home observation, relevant history and suggestions for resources and support. Typically, these assessments require about 10 hours.
- 2. **Extended support** to student/family as part of a maintenance plan that includes regular check ins/counseling beyond the intended short term stabilization of the wraparound services. Billed at hourly rate, length of service dependent on district/student need.
- **3. Parent/Guardian Groups:** Weekly groups over 6- 8 weeks, virtual or in person options are available depending on the group topics as detailed below:
  - **1.** "Positive Parent Program" 6 weeks, in person group offering specific, targeted parenting skills and strategies for caregivers of young children. (\$1500)
  - **2. School Avoidance/Refusal** 6-8 week, virtual group for parent/guardians struggling with children who are not attending school (\$1500-\$2000)
  - **3.** Parent/Guardian Support Group 6-8 week, virtual or in person groups for parents/guardians (\$1500- \$2000). These groups can address a specific topic, or cover several topics over the course of the time period. This could include some or all of the following:

Self-care, communication, parenting skills, stress management/anxiety, attachment, supporting grandparents etc

**Consultation Services:** (Purchased separately, based on staff availability and billed at an hourly rate or package):

- 1. Program or student specific consultation
- 2. Clinical Supervision/Consultation groups for school based counselors/psychologists.
- 3. Behavioral Analysis for student with moderate/severe disabilities

**Professional Development/Training:** (Purchased separately, based on staff availability. Cost is based on hourly rate, specific to length of training and prep time). Led by our staff who specialize in a variety of disciplines, including special education, mental health, autism, substance use and developmental disabilities, tailored to meet the needs of your district and staff. We also can provide Youth Mental Health First Aid training.
