The Orton-Gillingham Method for Teaching Reading and Spelling

This course will introduce teachers and paraprofessionals to the Orton-Gillingham method of teaching decoding and encoding to students who have language-based learning disabilities. This training emphasizes a direct, multisensory, and systematic approach to teaching reading based on current research in the field of reading and principles that have proven effective in teaching students who struggle to read. General education elementary teachers have found this training valuable for understanding the basic building blocks of teaching all children to read.
