- Display [this poster](#) for Mental Wellness Month.

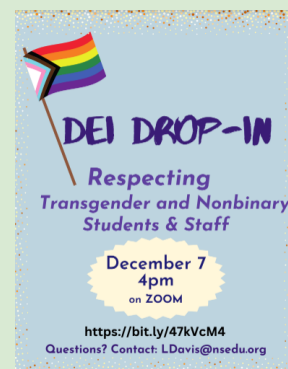
